ORDINANCE No 193/2020
OF THE RECTOR OF THE SILESIAN UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY
of 11 September 2020
about accommodation in the dormitory of the Silesian University of Technology

Pursuant to Article 23 (1) the Act of 20 July 2020 – The Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 85, as amended), it is ordered as follows:

§ 1

In the period of September 2, 2020, until further notice, the procedure of accommodation in the dormitory of the Silesian University of Technology (SUT), is specified in this Ordinance.

§ 2

1. Students of the Silesian University of Technology (SUT) and other persons are entitled be accommodated in the dormitory.
2. Before check-in, each person is required to undergo the obligatory body temperature measurement using a non-contact thermometer. The person taking the temperature measurement should wear gloves, protective mask and keep a safe distance. If the temperature is below 37,2 °C, person can enter the dormitory. In case doubts, the temperature is measured 3 times.
3. The person accommodated in the SUT's dormitory is obligated to use personal protective equipment – a mask covering the nose and mouth.
4. The person accommodated in the SUT's dormitory submits a declaration confirming:
 - 1) no symptoms which could point infection with the SARS-CoV-2 coronavirus,
 - 2) within 14 days have not had contact with a person with COVID-19,
 - 3) within 14 days have not been in quarantine in connection with infection of coronavirus.

§ 3

1. The person accommodated in the SUT's dormitory is obligated to follow all safety rules concerning the state of the COVID-19 epidemic, including prohibition of grouping in common areas (e.g. kitchen, corridor, etc.). Moreover, this person should regularly check body temperature and in case of its increase or noticed other symptoms that may indicate infection with a pathogen, should immediately inform the management or other staff of the dormitory.
2. During the stay in the SUT's dormitory, it is obligated to wear protective mask in the common rooms.
3. It is highly recommended to accommodate in a single rooms. It is allowed to accommodate in a larger number of persons, on condition their written approval (statement).
4. It is strictly forbidden to entertain visitors from outside.
5. The Manager of the dormitory prepares a list of persons to accommodate in a given dormitory and direct it for the decision to the Vice-Rector for Infrastructure and Promotion.

§ 4

The following Ordinance is revoked:

Ordinance no 107/2020 of the Rector of the Silesian University of Technology of 26 May 2020 on the procedure of student accommodation in a student house/ dormitory of the Silesian University of Technology (Legal Monitor of the Silesian University of Technology of 2020, item 430).

§ 5

This Ordinance enters into force as of the day it is signed, with an effect from 11 September 2020.
